We're excited to have Sugar Bowl back on our Far West Masters schedule, after several years absence due to scheduling difficulties. We will have two SL races at the Sugar Bowl race arena on Sat-Sun Jan. 23-24.

Social	Awards will be held at Judah Lodge, approx. 30 minutes following the races each day.

Our races will be held on the DVR Left run (Dave Van Ruiten) at the Sugar Bowl race arena, accessed from the Christmas Tree lift. Race day checkin will be 7:30-8:30 am daily on the main floor of the Judah Lodge; racer lift tickets will be available downstairs at the Special Window in the Judah Lodge. Racers can base themselves from Mid Mountain Lodge during the day. Awards will be held at Judah Lodge, approx. 30 minutes following the races each day.

After registration is closed Thursday evening, any late additions or withdrawals must be handled by contacting Sugar Bowl RA Kathy Williams – see organizer contact info above. No day-of-race signups will be accepted - you must be registered no later than the day before the race. No entry fee refunds will be granted after close of registration unless the organizer is contacted with injury/emergency withdrawal request and agrees to waive charges.

REMINDER: race day checkin is required!! You **must** check in on race day to confirm your participation and receive any information updates about the event program.

Helmets are required for all disciplines!

Competitors must be a current member of USSA and Far West Masters. New racers are welcome and may obtain an inexpensive temporary USSS competition license per race day.
