The 2018 Bernard Cup, held annually at Squaw Valley, home area of masters founder Bob Bernard, will feature GS races on Friday and Saturday and wrap up with a SL on Sunday feature a GS race on Friday and two SL races on Saturday and one on Sunday.

Note: the change made to the initial season schedule from a second GS race on Saturday to a SL race on Saturday was a decision made by the Far West Masters in consultation with the Squaw Race Department in early December.
