Heavenly Viva Italia SLx2 March 9, 2018

The annual Viva Italia races at Heavenly CA, originally planned for the first weekend in January, have been rescheduled of Friday March 9 with two SL races on the World Cup run at the California base area. (Regrettably, we were unable to reschedule the two GS races on Stagecoach originally planned for this event.)

The Viva Italia trophy, an iconic Far West event started by the legendary John Gianotti, will be awarded to the fastest overall man and women in both events, based on an age-handicap scoring formula.
