Mt. Rose is a great venue for us and always puts on a big welcome for the Far West Masters. The Silver Dollar GS track is one of the best venues on our schedule, providing competitors with a long and challenging course with multiple terrain features for course setters to exploit.

*** SCHEDULE OUTLOOK AS OF THU 3/1: coming into the end of February, Mt Rose believed it was unlikely that we could hold the planned GS races due to limited coverage with the continuing warm and dry conditions this season. However, the storms arriving this week are bringing much-needed snow and we may still be able to run GS. The fallback plan would be to switch to SL and run both races on Saturday 3/10. Decision is expected by the end of this week. ***
